



Tony Sanchez Scholarship Awards

SANCRA South Bay along with Nor Cal USA is proud to sponsor the Tony Sanchez Scholarship Award. Scholarships are available to students, professionals and non-profit organizations associated with Nor Cal USA, parks, recreation, community services or related fields. Up to \$500 will be granted to deserving candidates in an effort to provide financial assistance, encourage professional development and future contributions to the Parks and Recreation Profession.

A maximum of 3 recipients will be selected and may receive up to \$500 each. The 3 categories and criteria are as follows:

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

- Candidates must be residents of Monterey, San Benito, Santa Clara or Santa Cruz Counties.
- Candidates must be in good standing at an accredited university or college located within California Parks and Recreation Society's District's 4 or 6 www.cprs.org
- Award must be used towards tuition, books, or professional development. Receipt of how scholarship was spent may be requested.

PROFESSIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Candidate must be a part time, full time, contractor or volunteer with a recreation agency located within California Parks and Recreation Society's District's 4 or 6 www.cprs.org
- Award must be used toward professional development.

COMMUNITY SPORTS ORGANIZATION GRANT

- Organizations must be registered as non-profit with the State of California and located within California Parks and Recreation Society's District's 4 or 6 www.cprs.org
- Organizations must serve communities in Monterey, San Benito, Santa Clara or Santa Cruz Counties.
- Organizations must be making significant contributions to providing sporting opportunities.
- Award must be used toward advertisement, equipment, facility use fees, scholarships, safety/first aid, uniforms or other items as deemed appropriate by the Scholarship Committee.

Candidates for the three aforementioned scholarships must submit the corresponding application form, supplemental questions, and one letter of reference by **April 14, 2017 via mail** (postmarked by 4/14/17) **or email**.

Applications will be reviewed by the Tony Sanchez Scholarship Committee. Scholarships will be presented at the general membership meeting on May 18 at the Santa Clara Teen Center. Recipients will be notified by April 28.
